



## INFORMATION BULLETIN NO. 2

### Ordering of Cabinet Spares for Model 525P "OXFORD" Portable Radio.

Our Portable radio, the Model 525P "OXFORD", a sketch of which is shown above, is fitted with one of two cabinets, which at first glance appear to be the same. To avoid confusion and delay when ordering spares the following bulletin has been compiled.

## EARLY MODEL 525P

1. The early model is fitted with a perspex cabinet and comes in one of three colours:-
  - (a) Maroon
  - (b) Grey
  - (c) Cream

### 2. IDENTIFICATION OF CABINET FRONT.

There is a small depression into which the H.M.V. medallion is mounted.

### 3. IDENTIFICATION OF CABINET BACK

The entry Holes to the AC/Battery switch and the mains Plug are rectangular in shape.

### 4. HALF CENTRES

The left hand and right hand half centres are also made of Perspex.

### 5. BOTTOM COVER

The bottom cover is made of wood.

### 6. BATTERIES

The early Model uses one 467 and one C16 Battery.

## LATE MODEL 525P

1. The late model is fitted with a Bakelite cabinet and comes in one of three colours:-
  - (a) Maroon
  - (b) Brown
  - (c) White

### 2. IDENTIFICATION OF CABINET FRONT

There is no depression for mounting the H.M.V. Medallion.

### 3. IDENTIFICATION OF CABINET BACK

The entry Holes to the AC/Battery switch is round while that to the Power Plug is rectangular.

### 4. HALF CENTRES.

The half centres are made of painted aluminium and are interchangeable.

### 5. BOTTOM COVER

Also made of painted aluminium.

### 6. BATTERIES.

The late Model uses one 467 and 3 701 Batteries.
