NOTES.

Where a "+" sign follows the number of valves thus: 6+ it indicates that a magic-eye tuning indicator is used.

The dates listed are those given in the relevant Service Data Sheets. In most cases these dates correspond to the year in which the model was released, though in some cases production extended over more than one year.

MODEL NUMBERING SYSTEMS. Between 1945-1954 this system consisted of three (or four) numeral(s) usually in conjunction with one or more letter suffixes. The first two numerals indicated the year of issue, e.g 49 = 1949, and the third (and fourth) numerals indicated the number of valves used. The suffixes are explained as follows:

A = used to distinguish between two models having the same number of valves.

AR = car radio, AW = all wave, CRG = radiogram with auto changer, D = dual wave

P = portable, RG = radiogram, RP = record player without radio,

SB = bandsread on shortwave, T/RG = table model radiogram.

NEWER MODEL NUMBERING SYSTEM. Commencing towards the end of 1954 a new four-digit system was introduced. Here the first two numerals indicated the year of issue, and the last two numerals indicated serially the number of different models issued in any particular year. *Note: Some model numbers used in the 1960s did not confirm with this system. Note: two different Bradford*
