

NZVRS Members' Auction Sales Vendor Form

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

i26-5

1. All items not donated to the society must be entered on these forms which must be handed to the auctioneer prior to the commencement of the auction.
2. Any reserve prices are to be clearly indicated in the "Reserve Price" column.
3. Vendor's initials and lot number must be marked on each item or group of items.
4. No more than **10** items may be entered on any one sheet. Additional sheets may be used but prefixed A, B, etc
5. Items should preferably belong to the valve era and/or be at least 30 years old. Other items may be offered for sale at the discretion of the auctioneer.
6. Please indicate in good faith the "Condition" of the items if known - eg working (W) or not working (NW).
7. A minimum starting bid of \$1 is required from bidders unless specified otherwise by the auctioneer. Items not reaching the minimum bid (or reserve) will be passed in and remain the property of the **vendor - and remain their responsibility for removal after the auction has concluded.**
8. Abandoned lots are not appreciated, however items donated to the Society are usually welcomed - please contact the president, secretary, treasurer or any committee member before the auction night.
9. All items are offered on an "**as is, where is**" basis. Transactions are conducted in an open and in good faith manner, however the NZVRS is not financially responsible for any transaction(s), nor their electrical safety.
